## REFLECTING ON GOD'S WORD

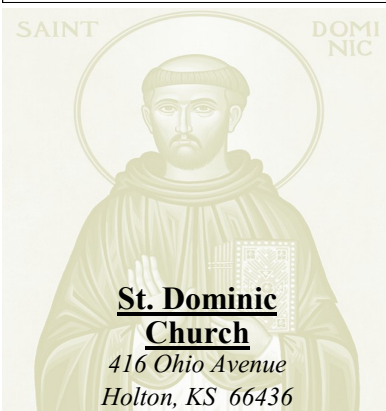
Today's reading comes from the end of the Bread of Life discourse in John's Gospel. In this discourse, Jesus teaches the crowds that he is "the living bread" from heaven. As we heard in the first reading, God provided food to his people during the desert wandering. Now, Jesus clearly states that his body is the food given by God for our pilgrimage on earth. As the manna was life-giving and revelatory, Jesus' body is even more so. Jesus declares that all who partake of his body "will live forever" and that he gives his body for "the life of the world". Here is a double emphasis on the life-giving nature of his body as well as a broadening of God's providential care beyond the people of Israel.

We also see in this reading the revelatory nature of the gift of Jesus' Body and Blood. Jesus stresses that whoever partakes of his Body and Blood "remains in me and I in him". There is a real transformation that occurs in our reception of the Eucharist whereby, in receiving the Body of Christ, we become the Body of Christ, the Church. This is part of the salvific action of Christ, whose bloody sacrifice on the cross we commemorate at each Mass through the unbloody sacrifice on the altar. Our celebration today reminds us of the life-giving and revelatory gift of Jesus' Body and Blood that we accept when we receive the Eucharist. Having thus been formed in Christ and nourished by his very self, our daily actions should reflect the reality of being members of the Body of Christ.

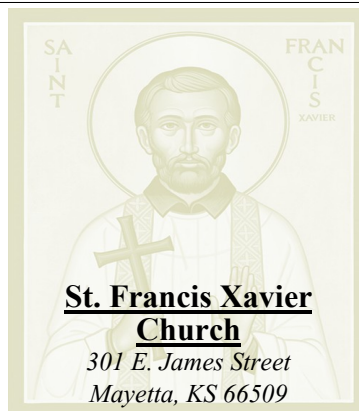

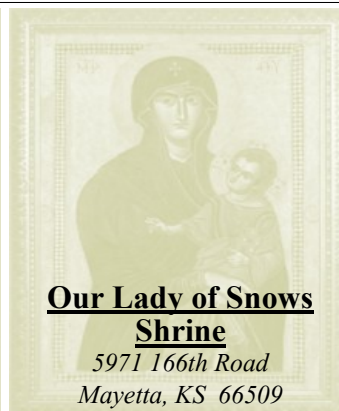

## THEMES: CORPUS CHRISTI, YEAR A

*Corpus Christi invites us to think about what it means to receive Jesus in the Eucharist. The readings help us see how God feeds his people and draws them together as one..*

- ◆ **Living Bread from Heaven:** Jesus calls himself the living bread. This reminds us that the Eucharist is not just a symbol, but real food for our souls.
- ◆ **God Provides in Hard Times:** In the desert, God gave manna and water to His people. This shows he cares for us even when things are hard.
- ◆ **Unity Through the Eucharist:** Sharing one bread brings us together. The Eucharist makes us one Church, one body in Christ.
- ◆ **True Life in Christ:** Jesus says we must eat his flesh and drink his blood to have life. The Eucharist connects us to eternal life.
- ◆ **Trusting God's Word:** God told his people they live by his word, not just by bread. We are reminded to listen and trust him, especially when we are unsure.
- ◆ **Sacrifice and Gift:** The Holy Spirit brings us closer to God. He helps us grow in faith and guides us in living out God's will.
- ◆ **Memory of Salvation:** God told his people to remember what he did for them. The Eucharist helps us remember Jesus and what he has done to save us.

*Corpus Christi Year A calls us to treasure the gift of the Eucharist. It reminds us that Jesus is with us in every Mass, feeding us and making us one.*

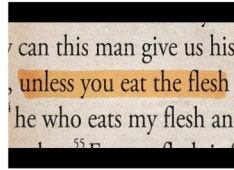
